  - a) Five new elected Board positions would be created which carry with them more defined responsibilities to help focus efforts and better delineate ownership of tasks. The COBF Officers in addition to their currently defined duties would also assist the directors below.
    - a. Sponsorship Director Lead and manage the COBF's relationships with sponsors and creating new relationships. Securing sponsorship donations, managing prizes, distribution etc.
    - b. Membership Director Lead and manage member recruitment efforts, membership materials and membership roster/communications etc.
    - c. Public Relations Director Lead the effort to organize COBF booths, seminars, public/youth bowfishing outings and get the word out on the COBF.
    - d. Tournament Director along with Regional Reps. this position would the lead for all aspects relating to organizing and running COBF organized tournaments, making sure all items are present, preparing documents, keeping records, managing points etc.
    - e. DOW Liaison –Lead efforts and be responsible for maintaining relationships with the DOW, handling all issue papers and staying on top of any and all Wildlife Commission activities and DOW changes that may impact the sport of bowfishing.
  - b) If such a change is enacted, the COBF Board of Directors in total would be made of the elected COBF Officers (President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary), the previous past-year's President & Vice President, plus the five new elected positions listed in (b) above.
  - c) The Regional Representative positions would no longer have seats on the COBF Board. The intent of this change is to permit members to become more involved without the full obligations and commitments that come with Board positions. In addition to the existing Regional Representative responsibilities (promoting and working the COBF in their regions) as defined in the Bylaws; the Regional Reps. would be required report to the Board and directly assist Board members with various tasks throughout the year, such as organizing and running events. Regional Representative positions would continue to be filled via either direct unelected Board appointments or general membership elections, and/or removed at the Board's discretion (as currently defined in the Bylaws).
